



## **Registered Nurse (RN)**

Join our team and help us meet our mission to provide the services needed for frail elderly and disabled adults to remain independent and retain their dignity while engaging in an active social life. When additional R.N. support is needed, under the supervision of the Program Director and with a team of skilled peers, the Registered Nurse (R.N.) provides nursing services in our Adult Day Health Care Programs while overseeing 25-60 participants depending on location. The R.N. is a key member of the center's Inter-disciplinary team that provides health services for the frail elderly, disabled adults and adults with Alzheimer's Disease. The R.N. provides nursing services including emergency care, evaluating participant needs, writing and implementing nursing care plans, administering medication, communicating with doctors and family and maintaining participant records.

### **Qualifications:**

- Graduation from an accredited program for Registered Nurses and a current California Registered Nurse License is required.
- Qualified applicants must have the knowledge and be sensitive to the physical, mental, and social needs of the elderly.
- Prefer one year of experience working in a health setting with older adults, people with disabilities or Alzheimer's disease.
- Must possess and maintain current first aid and CPR certification and be proficient in Microsoft Word.
